When used to treat primary axillary hyperhidrosis, small doses of an injectable form of the sterile purified botulinum toxin stop release of the chemical messenger acetylcholine, temporarily blocking the nerves in the underarm that stimulate sweating.

BOTOX® has been in use since 1989 to treat several medical disorders. Most recently, in 2002, it was approved as BOTOX® Cosmetic to temporarily improve the appearance of moderate to severe frown lines between the eyebrows. In two clinical trials involving over 600 adults, those who received BOTOX® had significantly reduced underarm sweating as compared to the placebo group. The average duration of response following the first treatment was 170 days.
